

Author Kills Toronto Mayor In Novel, Wins Conversation With Him

The winner of The Mark's "Win a Conversation With David Miller" contest flies to Toronto today for a face-to-face meeting with the former Mayor

TORONTO (November 19, 2010) – Robin Spano murdered Toronto Mayor David Miller. In her novel, that is. Today, Spano, winner of The Mark's "[Win a Conversation With David Miller](#)" contest, flies to Toronto from Vancouver to chat with Miller, who she once so detested that she killed him off in a novel, about the policies that made her come to like him: supporting small businesses, making cities more "green". She also intends to give him a signed copy of her book.

Miller had originally committed to a 15-minute video-chat, but has since invited Spano for a 30-minute face-to-face meeting.

The Spano-Miller conversation is the result of a [contest](#) launched by TheMarkNews.com that allowed users to win a video-chat with Mr. Miller.

The audience gave the most votes to Robin Spano's entry, which explained that she had been so furious with Miller for raising taxes on small businesses that she wrote a murder mystery in which the mayor was killed. But Miller grew on her as he pursued environmentally friendly policies and she eventually came to regret the fictional homicide. She wanted to win the conversation with Miller to talk about small businesses, environmental policy and to thank him for inspiring her to write.
